Washington is currently in a heated debate about our federal budget. Significant cuts are likely to federal agencies such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), which has been operating under a "Continuing Resolution" for 6 months. Because this is clearly one of the most complex budget years in memory, The CPH Foundation produced three short videos help inform the public about how this debate might impact disease control and prevention funding.
